

FIREWORKS ACT 2003 - FIREWORKS REGULATIONS 2004

Application for annual firework suppliers licence - retail premises

Fireworks may normally only be sold on four occasions throughout the year as follows:

- from 15th October to 10th November inclusive;
- 26th December to 31st December inclusive;
- on the first day of the Chinese New Year and three days immediately preceding it, and
- on the day of Diwali and three days immediately preceding it.

If you wish to sell fireworks during the rest of the year this annual licence will be needed.

An application for any licence may be refused, or one already issued under the above Regulations to supply fireworks throughout the year may be revoked if offences have been or are committed by the applicant under the explosives storage requirements of the Manufacture and Storage of Explosives Regulations 2005, the Health and Safety at Work etc Act 1974 or of contraventions relating to the supply of fireworks not complying with the relevant British Standards or of Sales to Underage Persons.

If a licence is refused or revoked we will inform you in writing and you have a right of appeal against that decision to Croydon Magistrates' Court.
