PROPOSED INTRODUCTION OF A GOODS VEHICLE LOADING BAY IN SYDENHAM ROAD, SELHURST

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Croydon Council propose to make a Traffic Order under the relevant sections of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Traffic Management Act 2004 and all other enabling powers.
2. The general effect of the Order would be:-
 - (a) to designate a free parking place in Sydenham Road, Selhurst, the north-west side, from a point 1.00 metre north-east of the south-western flank wall of No. 407 Sydenham Road north-eastward for a distance of 10.00 metres;
 - (b) to provide that the parking place would be in operation between the hours of 9am and 5pm on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive;
 - (c) to specify that the use of the parking place would be restricted to goods vehicles only for the purpose of loading or unloading goods or delivering or collecting goods from premises adjacent to the parking place;
 - (d) to restrict to 30 minutes any one period of waiting in the parking place and to prohibit the return to the same parking place of the same vehicle for a period of one hour;
 - (e) to provide that the parking place may be suspended when necessary to facilitate the carrying out of certain functions such as building or street works, furniture removals, funerals, etc.
3. A copy of the proposed Order, of the Council's statement of reasons for proposing to make the Order, and of a map which indicates the length of road to which the proposed Order relates can be inspected until the last day of a period of six weeks beginning with the date on which the Order was made or, as the case may be, the Council decides not to make the Order, during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive at the Enquiry Counter, "One Stop" Facility, Taberner House, Park Lane, Croydon, Surrey.

Persons desiring to object to the proposed Order should send a statement in writing of their objection and the grounds thereof to the Order Making Section, Community Services Department, 9th Floor, South-West Side, Taberner House, Park Lane, Croydon, CR9 1EN quoting the reference CS/PS/JGH/7/Z18 by 2 July 2008.
6. The proposed Order is intended to introduce a limited time goods vehicle loading bay in Sydenham Road to facilitate vehicles delivering goods to premises, which will benefit local businesses.
