ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984 SECTION 14, AS AMENDED BY SECTION 4(7) OF SCHEDULE 5 TO THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT, 1985 AND THE TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ACT 2004.

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC

1. Croydon Council **HEREBY GIVE NOTICE** that to carry out highway maintenance works, they have made an Order the effect of which will be to:
 - (a) temporarily close to vehicular traffic those streets or length of street specified in the Schedule to this Notice;
 - (b) temporarily close any adjoining streets to those mentioned in the Schedule to vehicular traffic where this is considered necessary to facilitate the work in progress;
 - (c) temporarily introduce waiting restrictions at any time throughout the week should this be required.
2. Wherever the work happens to be in progress in those streets or lengths of streets specified in the Schedules to this Notice, no person may cause or permit any vehicle to
 - (a) proceed in a direction other than that indicated by a traffic sign, or
 - (b) proceed in any street or length of street which may at the time be subject to a road closure until the completion of the work allows.
3. Whilst the provisions of the Order remain in force, waiting or loading by vehicles will be prohibited at any time throughout the week in those streets or lengths of street specified where work is in progress. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction on waiting imposed by this Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986, as amended.
4. During the prohibition referred to in paragraph 2 above, displaced traffic will be diverted via local streets as appropriate.
5. The Order will come into operation on the **23rd June 2008** and is likely to remain in force for about 6 months.

(Note: Whilst the Order is expected to remain in force for 6 months, it is anticipated that the actual works will take up to a maximum of 6 weeks. The provisions of the Order will only apply during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs, Regulations and General Directions 2002. Access for frontagers will be maintained as far as possible whilst the work proceeds.

Russell Hill Place, Purley
St Andrews Road, Coulsdon (Woodmansterne Road to Richmond Road)
Hermitage Road, Upper Norwood (Chevening Road to Central Hill)
Leighton Street, Croydon
Clifford Road, South Norwood (Portland Road to Carmichael Road)
Frith Road, Croydon (junction with Drummond Road)
Coombe Road, Croydon (junction with Park Lane)
Crowley Crescent, Waddon (Barrow Road to Goodwin Road)

Note :- During the progress of the works One Way Working and No Entry Orders in adjoining streets may be suspended as necessary to allow access to properties in those streets affected by the works.
