THE CROYDON (WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTION) (AMENDMENT NO. 6)
ORDER 2008.

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Croydon Council on the 23 June 2008 made the above mentioned Order under the relevant sections of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended.
2. **The general effect of the Order would be to:-**
 - (a) **introduce waiting restrictions “at any time” throughout the week in the lengths of streets specified in Schedule 1 to this Notice;**
 - (b) **introduce loading restrictions “at any time” throughout the week in a length of Keeley Road specified in Schedule 2 to this Notice.**
3. Copies of the Order, which will come into operation on 30 June 2008, (and of any Orders which have previously amended those Orders) can be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive, until the end of six weeks from the date on which the Order was made at the Enquiry Counter, "One Stop" Facility, Taberner House, Park Lane, Croydon, Surrey.
4. Copies of the Order may be obtained from Parking Services, Community Services Department, 9th Floor, Taberner House, Park Lane, Croydon, CR9 1EN.
5. Any person desiring to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any relevant regulations made there under have not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within six weeks of the date on which the Order was made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.

SCHEDULE 1

Beulah Hill – the north side, for 10 metres either side of Queen Mary Road

Beverstone Road – both sides, for 10 metres from Langdale Road

Boulogne Road – the south-west side, outside No. 26 Boulogne Road and across the entrance to the Continuing Education Service Centre, Boulogne Road

Braemar Avenue – both sides, for 10 metres from Brantwood Road

Brantwood Road – the south-east side, for 10 metres either side of its junctions with Grange Road and Braemar Avenue

Court Wood Lane – the east side, for 10 metres either side of its northernmost junction with Markfield

Curlew Close – both sides, for 10 metres from Sandpiper Road

Dalton Close – whole road

Ederline Avenue – the south-east side, across the entrance to Chatsworth Court, Ederline Avenue

Gloucester Road – the south-east side, for 10 metres either side of its junction with Tait Road

Grange Road, South Croydon – both sides, for 10 metres from its junction with Brantwood Road

Keeley Road – (a) the north-west side, for 10 metres from the south-western kerb-line of Keeley Road;
(b) the south-west side, for 10 metres from the north-western kerb-line of Keeley Road.

Langdale Road – (a) the north-west side, for 10 metres either side of its junction with Wiltshire Road
(b) the south-east side,
(i) for 10 metres either side of its junction with Beverstone Road
(ii) for 10 metres either side of its junction with Nutfield Road

Lower Barn Road – the south-east side, for 10 metres either side of its junction with Dalton Close

Markfield – the northernmost arm,
(a) the north-west side
(b) the south side, for 20 metres from its junction with Court Wood Lane

Nutfield Road - both sides, for 10 metres from Langdale Road

Queen Mary Road – both sides, for 10 metres from Beulah Hill

Redwing Close - both sides, for 10 metres from Sandpiper Road

Sandpiper Road – (a) the north-east and south-east sides,
(i) for 10 metres either side of its junction with Redwing Close
(ii) across the frontage of No. 10 Sandpiper Road
(iii) opposite Nos. 9 to 19 Sandpiper Road
(b) the south-west side, from a point opposite the entrance to Greenvale Primary School to a point 10 metres north of Redwing Close

Stambourne Way – the north side, from opposite No. 2 Stambourne Way to a point 10 metres east of Summit Way

Stratford Road - both sides, for 10 metres from Wiltshire Road

Summit Way - both sides, for 10 metres from Stambourne Way

Tait Road – (a) the north side, for 10 metres from Gloucester Road
(b) the south side, so much as is public highway

Wiltshire Road – (a) both sides, for 10 metres from Langdale Road
(b) the north-east side, for 10 metres either side of Stratford Road

Keeley Road - (a) the north-west side, for 10 metres from the south-western kerb-line of Keeley Road;
(b) the south-west side, for 10 metres from the north-western kerb-line of Keeley Road.
