CARMICHAEL ROAD, SOUTH NORWOOD

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF PEDESTRIAN TRAFFIC

1. Croydon Council, HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate drainage connections to a new development they have made an order the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit pedestrian movements in Carmichael Road, South Norwood.
2. Whilst the said works are taking place no person shall proceed along the public footway which lies on the north-west side of Carmichael Road, between the common boundary of Nos. 70 and 72 Carmichael Road and its south-western extremity.
3. Whilst the Order remains in force the alternative route for pedestrians will be via the opposite footway.
4. The Order will come into operation on 1 July 2008 and the Order will remain in force for 18 months.

(Vehicular and pedestrian access will be maintained)
