CROYDON COUNCIL ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984 SECTION 14, AS AMENDED THE ROAD TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT 1991 TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC

PLEASANT GROVE, CROYDON

- 1. Croydon Council, **HEREBY GIVE NOTICE** that to facilitate works to a water service pipe they have made an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily restrict traffic in Pleasant Grove, Croydon.
- 2. Whilst the said works are taking place the carriageway and footway of Pleasant Grove will be closed outside No. 39.
- 3. During the closure the alternative route for vehicular traffic will be via Limetree Grove, Heathway, Shirley Way, Temple Avenue and vice versa. Pedestrians will be diverted to a walkway in the carriageway.
- 4. The Order will come into operation on the 21 August 2023, and it is anticipated that the works will be carried out within approximately five days. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required. The prohibition will only apply during such times and to such extents as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- 5. These restrictions shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) A vehicle involved in the said works.
 - (b) A vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes.
 - (c) Anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
