THE BRIDLE ROAD, PURLEY

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC

- 1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate gas connection works by SGN, they intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily prohibit traffic movements in The Bridle Road, Purley.
- 2. Whilst the said works are taking place The Bridle Road will be closed at its junction with Foxley Lane.
- 3. During the closure the diversion routes for vehicular traffic will be via Foxley Lane, Peaks Hill Rise, Peaks Hill and Plough Lane and reversed, or via Foxley Lane, Plough Lane and vice versa, as appropriately signed. Residents' access will be maintained.
- 4. The Order will come into operation on 08 September 2023, and it is anticipated that the works will be completed on 22 September 2023. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further works be required. The prohibitions will only apply during such times and to such extents as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- 5. These restrictions shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) any vehicle involved in carrying out the said works.
 - (b) any vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes.
 - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
