**WAITING RESTRICTIONS IN VARIOUS LOCATIONS IN CROYDON**

The Croydon (Prohibition and Restriction of Stopping, Loading and Waiting) and  
(Free Parking Places) (No.19) Order 2023

The Croydon (On-Street Charged-For Parking Places) (No.19) Order 2023

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Croydon Council on 29 August 2023 made the above Traffic Orders under the relevant sections of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, and all other enabling powers.
2. **The general effect of the Orders will be:**
  - a) **To introduce “at any time” double yellow line waiting restrictions in the lengths of streets specified in the Schedule to this Notice.**
  - b) **To update the map-based tiles to the Schedule attached to the above Orders to accurately represent the new arrangements as they exist on site.**
3. Copies of the Orders, which will come into operation on 04 September 2023, and of all associated Orders can be inspected by appointment with the Parking Design Team from 9am to 4pm on Mondays to Fridays inclusive until the end of six weeks from the date on which the Orders were made, at the “Access Croydon” Facility, 8 Mint Walk, Croydon, CR0 1EA (telephone 020 8726 6000 and ask for Parking Design).

Any person desiring to question the validity of the Orders or of any provision contained therein on the ground that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any relevant regulations made there under have not been complied with in relation to the Orders may, within six weeks of the date on which the Orders were made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.

**SCHEDULE**

**(Introducing double yellow line waiting restrictions “at any time”)**

**Bartlett Street, South Croydon**

The north side, amending the existing single yellow line to double yellow lines along the entire length of that side of the road.

**Lodge Lane, Croydon**

Both sides, extending from the turning head at the north-western extremity of Lodge Lane (fronting property Nos. 267, 277 and 287) for 13 metres south-eastwards on the south-west side, and up to the existing disabled bay on the north-east side. Including the turning head itself.
