FOOTPATH NO. 850, UNDERWOOD, FIELD WAY, CROYDON

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF PEDESTRIAN TRAFFIC

- Croydon Council, HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate works by UKPN, they have made an order the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit pedestrian movements on Footpath No. 850, which serves Nos. 1 to 83 Underwood, Field Way.
- Whilst the said works are taking place no person shall proceed along Public Footpath No.850 adjacent to the flank wall of Nos. 76 to 83 Underwood, Field Way.
- 3. Whilst the Order remains in force the alternative route for pedestrians will be via a temporary footpath, as appropriately signed.
- 4. The Order will come into operation on 08 May 2024, and it is anticipated that the works will be carried out within three days. However, the Order will remain in force for 6 months to be reintroduced should further work be required. The prohibition will only apply during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- Nothing in this Order shall apply to anyone carrying out the said works, or to anything done for police, ambulance, or fire brigade purposes or with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a civil enforcement officer.
