# Introduction

A referendum was held in October 2021 where the voters of Croydon were asked to decide how they would like the borough to be represented. The question asked was – whether the existing model of leader and cabinet should be maintained or a new model of an elected mayor be introduced.

The voters of Croydon chose the new model of governance – of an elected mayor. 47,165 electors voted in favour of having an elected mayor with 11,519 voting to maintain the existing model of leader and cabinet.

# On Thursday 5 May 2022 you have the chance to vote for the candidate you wish to be Croydon's first elected mayor.

The elected mayor will provide leadership and direction for the borough and the council. They will be accountable for council policy and council services.

They will have a mandate to represent the whole borough and will speak on its behalf locally, regionally, nationally and internationally.

There are **8** candidates standing for election. The candidates will be listed on the ballot paper in alphabetical order. A sample ballot paper is shown on page 6.

The rules for running a Mayoral election require the Returning Officer to send every voter registered to vote in this election a copy of this booklet. All the candidates were able to choose whether they wished to have their statement included.



The order in which their statements appear in this booklet was determined by the drawing of lots. The content of each statement is the responsibility of the candidate. The views expressed cannot be attributed to the Returning Officer or Croydon Council.

This booklet also includes information regarding the election, including how to cast your votes – please remember you have a first and second choice vote for candidates in the mayoral election.

Please do take a look at **www.croydon.gov.uk/elections2022** where there is a lot of information about the election and the role and responsibilities of an elected Mayor.

On Thursday 5 May 2022, the election of the 70 ward councillors will also take place, so you will receive a second (yellow) ballot paper for this election when you vote. You will be able to vote for the number of candidates who represent your local area (ward). A full list of candidates can also be found at

## Who can vote?

To vote in the elections on 5 May, you must be included in the Croydon electoral register on the date of the election. The deadline to register to vote is **14 April 2022**.

All registered British, Commonwealth and European Union citizens will be entitled to vote.

You must be 18 years of age on or before 5 May 2022.

## How to cast your votes

The Mayoral ballot paper is white and will list all the candidates standing in alphabetical order. Next to the list of candidates will be two columns.

You will have two votes. Vote once in column one for your **first choice** candidate and once in column two for your **second choice** candidate.


If you vote more than once in either column your vote will not be counted.

You do not have to vote for a second choice candidate, but you must cast a first choice vote in column one. If you leave the column one blank your vote will not be counted.

If you do not vote in column two, your first choice will still be counted. However, if you vote for the same candidate twice, your second choice vote will not be counted.

The section on how the votes are counted on page 8 explains how the first and second choice votes work.







## How the votes are counted

If a candidate gets more than 50% of first-choice votes then they are elected as mayor.

If nobody gets more than 50% of first-choice votes, then the second-choice votes are counted. The two candidates with the highest number of votes stay in the contest. The other candidates are eliminated.

The second-choice votes on the ballot papers of the eliminated candidates are counted. Any that have been cast for one of the remaining candidates are added to their first-choice votes. The candidate with most votes after this is elected as mayor.



# **Role of the Mayor**

The directly elected Mayor provides leadership and direction to the borough and the Council and has overall responsibility for council policy and the delivery of services.

The elected Mayor has a mandate to represent the whole borough and will speak on its behalf locally, regionally, nationally and internationally. It will be for them to decide how this role will work in practice, within the boundaries set out in the Council's Constitution.

### The Mayor:

- sets priorities and policies which are delivered by council officers who make operational decisions and work in partnership with other organisations.
- holds all executive powers but may delegate them to the Cabinet, cabinet committees, individual cabinet members and officers. One of the Mayor's first decisions on being elected to office will be to decide upon a scheme of delegation.
- is involved in the appointment of statutory officers and Corporate Directors in accordance with the constitutional and proportional political party representative requirements of the Appointments and Disciplinary Committee. The statutory officers are the Head of Paid Service, Chief Finance Officer (Section 151 Officer), Monitoring Officer, Director of Children's Services, Director of Adult Social Services, Director of Public Health, and Scrutiny Officer.



 will promote, uphold and act in accordance with the Seven Principles of Public Life (the 'Nolan Principles'), Members' Code of Conduct and the Protocol on Staff-Councillor Relations.

The Council's Constitution sets out the Council's decision-making structures and rules. Work has been undertaken to revise this in readiness for the start of the elected Mayor's term of office to reflect the role and powers of the elected Mayor. This was agreed by Full Council on 23 March 2022.

### Appointment of deputy mayor and cabinet

The elected Mayor must appoint a deputy mayor who acts when they are unable to act. The Mayor must also appoint a cabinet of between 2 and 9 councillors, including the deputy mayor.

The Mayor must decide the portfolios of the cabinet members: the cabinet does not need to be politically balanced.



## Frequently asked questions

### When will the polling stations be open?

Polling stations will be open from **7am - 10pm** on **Thursday 5 May 2022**.

### Where is my polling station?

The location of your polling station is printed on your poll card. We also have an online polling station finder at www.croydon.gov.uk/elections2022

### I have lost my poll card, can I still vote?

Poll cards are for information – to tell you where your polling station is located and when it will be open. You don't need your poll card to vote.

## Do I need to take ID to the polling station?

You do not need to show ID to vote. You will need to tell polling staff your name and address, they will find you in the electoral register, and give you your ballot papers.

### When will the votes be counted?

The counting of votes will take place in the evening on Friday 6 May and results will be published at **www.croydon.gov.uk/elections2022** shortly after they are declared.



### Why two votes for one Mayor?

The law states that the voting process for Mayoral elections must be done this way. It allows you to say who would be your second choice for Mayor if your first choice is not in the top two after the first round of counting, and if there is not an outright majority winner at that stage.

#### What happens if I don't make a second choice?

Your first choice will still be counted.

# What happens if I only make an X in the second choice column?

Your vote will not be counted because no one will know who your first choice candidate is.

# What if I mark an X in the first choice column for more than one candidate?

Your vote will not be counted. If you wish to vote for two candidates then you must mark an X in column 1 for your first choice candidate and also an X in column 2 for your second choice candidate.

#### Why has every voter in my household been sent a booklet?

The law says that every registered voter must be sent their own copy, so they get a chance to see who the candidates are.

#### Do the candidates contribute to the cost of the booklet?

The law allows for the Returning Officer to require a contribution from candidates towards the cost of printing the booklets. All candidates contributed the same amount.


