PUBLIC FOOTPATH 162 (BETWEEN WHYTECLIFFE ROAD SOUTH AND HIGH STREET, PURLEY)

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF PEDESTRIAN TRAFFIC

- 1. Croydon Council, HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate cleaning and lighting installation works and the painting of a mural, they have made an order the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit pedestrian movements on Footpath No. 162, which extends between Whytecliffe Road South and High Street, Purley.
- 2. Whilst the said works are taking place no person shall proceed along Public Footpath No.162.
- 3. Whilst the Order remains in force the alternative route for pedestrians will be via Whytecliffe Road South and High Street, Purley.
- 4. The Order will come into operation on 05 May 2023 and it is anticipated that the works will be completed on 12 May 2023. However, the Order will remain in force for 6 months to be reintroduced should further work be required.
- 5. Nothing in this Order shall apply to anyone carrying out the said works, or to anything done for police, ambulance, or fire brigade purposes or with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform.
