TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF PEDESTRIAN TRAFFIC

- Croydon Council, HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate essential repairs to the footbridge, they intend to make an order the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit pedestrian movements on Footpath No. 48F, the railway footbridge between Roke Road and Little Roke Road.
- 2. Whilst the said works are taking place no person shall proceed along Public Footpath No.48F.
- 3. Whilst the Order remains in force the alternative route for pedestrians will be via Roke Road, Oaks Way, Park Road, Hayes Lane, Godstone Road, Little Roke Road and vice versa.
- 4. The Order will come into operation on 21 May 2023 and it is anticipated that the works will be completed on 17 October 2023. However, the Order will remain in force for 6 months to be reintroduced if further work is necessary.
- 5. Nothing in this Order shall apply to anyone carrying out the said works, or to anything done for police, ambulance, or fire brigade purposes or with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform.
