ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984, SECTION 14 AS AMENDED THE ROAD TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT 1991 AND ALL OTHER ENABLING POWERS

GRIMWADE AVENUE, CROYDON

TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF TRAFFIC

- 1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate works to a water service pipe, they intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily restrict traffic movements in Grimwade Avenue, Croydon.
- 2. Whilst the said works are taking place:
- a) the south-eastern (odd-numbered side) footway of Grimwade Avenue will be closed between the common boundary of Nos. 9 and 11 and the common boundary of Nos. 23 and 25 Grimwade Avenue.
- b) the carriageway of Grimwade Avenue will be closed between the common boundary of Nos. 9 and 11 and the common boundary of Nos. 23 and 25 Grimwade Avenue.
- 3. Whilst the closure remains in force the alternative routes for diverted vehicular traffic will be via Mapledale Avenue, Fitzjames Avenue, Sandilands, Grimwade Avenue and reversed, as appropriately signed. Pedestrians will be diverted to the opposite footway.
- 4. The Order will come into operation on 19 June 2023, and it is anticipated that the works will be carried out in five days. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further works be required.
- 5. These restrictions shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) any vehicle involved in carrying out the said works.
 - (b) any vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes.
 - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
