ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984, SECTION 14

AND THE ROAD TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT 1991
BLUNT ROAD, SOUTH CROYDON
TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC

1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate telegraph pole replacement works, they have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily restrict traffic in Blunt Road, South Croydon.
2. Whilst the said works are taking place:
 - a) The carriageway of Blunt Road will be closed at its junction with St Peter's Road.
 - b) The northern footway of Blunt Road will be closed outside Nos. 10 to 17 Blunt Road.
3. Whilst the works are taking place, pedestrians will be diverted to the opposite footway.
4. The restrictions shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) any person or vehicle involved in carrying out the said works.
 - (b) any vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes.
 - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
5. The Order will come into operation on 21 May 2023, and it is anticipated that the works will be carried out within one day. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be re-introduced should further works be required.
