ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984, SECTION 14 AS AMENDED
THE ROAD TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT 1991
AND ALL OTHER ENABLING POWERS

BURLINGTON ROAD, THORNTON HEATH
TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF TRAFFIC

1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate new sewer connection works and the construction of a manhole on behalf of Thames Water, they have made an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily restrict traffic movements in Burlington Road, Thornton Heath.
2. Whilst the said works are taking place, both the carriageway and north-western footway of Burlington Road will be closed outside Nos. 21 to 25 Burlington Road.
3. Whilst the closure remains in force the alternative routes for diverted vehicular traffic will be as detailed below. Pedestrians will be directed to use the opposite footway.
 - Southbound traffic from Beulah Crescent: Via Norbury Road, Moffat Road, and Speke Road.
 - Northbound traffic from Beulah Crescent: Via Osborne Road, Northwood Road, and Penrith Road.
 - Westbound traffic from Burlington Road: Via Speke Road, Moffat Road, and Norbury Road.
4. The restrictions shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) any person or vehicle involved in carrying out the said works.
 - (b) any vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes.
 - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
5. The Order will come into operation on 29 May 2023, and it is anticipated that the works will be completed on 09 June 2023. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required. The restriction will only apply during such times and to such extents as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
