ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984, SECTION 14 AS AMENDED THE ROAD TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT 1991 AND ALL OTHER ENABLING POWERS

OLD LODGE LANE, PURLEY TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC

- Croydon Council, HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate maintenance of the railway bridge they have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic movements in Old Lodge Lane, Purley.
- 2. Whilst the said works are taking place Old Lodge Lane will be closed from a point 10 metres north-west of the railway bridge (situated between the junction with Watney Close and No. 6 Old Lodge Lane) to a point 10 metres south-east of that railway bridge.
- 3. Whilst the Order remains in force the alternative routes for traffic will be via Brighton Road, Farthing Way, Marlpit Lane, Coulsdon Road, Stoneyfield Road, Hartley Down and vice versa, or via Brighton Road, Stoats Nest Road, Coulsdon Road, Hartley Down and vice versa, as appropriately signed. Access to properties will be maintained.
- 4. The Order will come into operation on 25 May 2023, and it is anticipated that the works will be completed on approximately 14 July 2023. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required.
- 5. The restriction will only apply during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs, Regulations and General Directions 2016.
- 6. The restriction shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) a vehicle being used to carry out the said work.
 - (b) a vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes.
 - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
