THE ROSERY, CROYDON

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF PEDESTRIAN AND VEHICULAR TRAFFIC

- 1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to allow water service pipe repair works, they intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily prohibit pedestrian and vehicular traffic movements in The Rosery.
- 2. Whilst the said works are taking place:
 - (a) The Rosery will be closed to vehicular traffic between its junction with Bywood Avenue and the common boundary of Nos. 6 and 8 The Rosery.
 - (b) The western (even-numbered side) footway of The Rosery will be closed to pedestrians between its junction with Bywood Avenue and the common boundary of Nos. 6 and 8 The Rosery.
- 3. Whilst the Order remains in force the alternative route for vehicular traffic will be via The Rosery, Bywood Avenue and vice versa. Pedestrian traffic will be diverted to the opposite footway.
- 4. The Order will come into operation on 12 June 2023, and it is anticipated that the works will be carried out in five days. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required. The prohibitions will only apply during such times and to such an extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- 5. The restrictions will not apply in respect of:
 - (a) any vehicle or person involved in carrying out the said works.
 - (b) any vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes.
 - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
