# Croydon Council – Fact Sheet for residents applying for a Disabled Persons Freedom Pass

# Eligibility Criteria - Without Speech

Without Speech - means you cannot communicate verbally in any language.

#### Also note:

 The Department for Transport had advised this does not apply to people who are able to communicate orally but whose speech may be slow or difficult to understand, for example because of a severe stammer.

#### Evidence you could provide:

- Personal Independence Payment (PIP) award letter where under "Communicating verbally" your score is 8 points or more.
- If you do not have PIP or do not meet the above criteria medical evidence would be required to support your application.

#### Notes on providing evidence to support your application:

## Documents supplied must:

- be relevant to the eligibility criteria you are applying under
- show your name and address

#### For example:

- a letter of diagnosis
- evidence of specialist consultations etc.
- letters from other professionals involved in your care

Please do not ask your GP to write a letter on your behalf. We will not be able to consider this. We cannot accept appointment letters as proof, please do not send these.
