ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 16A AS AMENDED BY THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION (SPECIAL EVENTS) ACT 1994 TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC ORDER

ABERDEEN ROAD, PARKER ROAD, SOUTHBRIDGE ROAD AND SOUTH END CROYDON FOOD & MUSIC FESTIVAL ASSOCIATED RESTRICTIONS

- 1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate the Croydon Food & Music Festival they intend to make a Traffic Order, the effect of which will be to:
 - (a) introduce a road closure in South End, between its junctions with Aberdeen Road and Coombe Road.
 - (b) suspend the one-way working in Parker Road.
 - (c) suspend parking and introduce waiting and loading restrictions between 7am and Midnight in: -
 - (i) Aberdeen Road
 - (ii) Southbridge Road
 - (iii) South End (between its junctions with Aberdeen Road and Coombe Road).

Note: Parking within Spices Yard car park will also be suspended.

- 2. The Order will come into effect on 02 July 2023 and will remain in force for one day.
- 3. Diversions for displaced traffic will be as detailed below.
- From South Croydon: Via Aberdeen Road, St Peters Road, and Coombe Road.
- From Central Croydon: Via Lower Coombe Street and Southbridge Road.
- 4. The restrictions shall not apply in respect of:
- (a) A vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes.
- (b) Anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
