ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 16A
AS AMENDED BY THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION (SPECIAL EVENTS) ACT 1994
TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC & PARKING ORDER
COYDON MELA - ASSOCIATED RESTRICTIONS

1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate the Croydon Mela event they intend to make an Order the effect of which will be to:
 - Close the streets in Schedule 1 to this Notice to vehicular traffic.
 - Suspend parking and introduce temporary waiting and loading restrictions operating “at any time” in the streets in Schedule 2 to this Notice.
2. The provisions of the Order will not prevent access being maintained for pedestrians to any premises situated on or adjacent to any road to which this Order relates, or to any other premises accessible from, and only from, such a road. Access for residents’ vehicles and emergency services will be maintained.
3. The Order will come into effect on the Sunday 16 July 2023 and will remain in force for a period of one day.
4. Nothing in the Order shall apply:
 - a) to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform.
 - b) to any vehicle being used in connection with the staging of the event.
 - c) to any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes, or the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity, or water to premises in the area, which necessitates the bringing of vehicles into a section of road to which the order applies.
