FERNHAM ROAD, THORNTON HEATH

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC & PARKING

- Croydon Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate water service pipe works on behalf of Thames Water, they intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily prohibit traffic and parking in Fernham Road, Thornton Heath.
- 2. Whilst the said works are taking place:
- a) The carriageway and the south-eastern footway of Fernham Road will be closed outside No. 7.
- b) Parking outside Nos. 7 to 11 and 18 to 20 Fernham Road will be suspended and waiting and loading restrictions will apply at any time.
- 3. During the closure, the diversion routes for vehicular traffic will be via Beulah Road, Parchmore Road and Fernham Road and reversed or via Bellevue Park, Bulganak Road, Parchmore Road and Fernham Road and reversed. Pedestrians will be directed to the opposite footway.
- 4. The Order will come into operation on 17 July 2023, and it is anticipated that the work will be carried out within five days. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required. The prohibitions will only apply during such times and to such extents as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- 5. These restrictions shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) any person or vehicle involved in carrying out the said works.
 - (b) any vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes.
 - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
