ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984, SECTION 14 AS AMENDED

AND ALL OTHER ENABLING POWERS

GRECIAN CRESCENT, UPPER NORWOOD  
TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC

1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate bus shelter replacement works, they intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily restrict vehicular traffic movements in Grecian Crescent, Upper Norwood.
2. Whilst the said works are taking place Grecian Crescent will be closed at its at its northernmost junction with Beulah Hill.
3. Whilst the closure remains in force the alternative route for diverted traffic will be via Beulah Hill, Grecian Crescent, Preston Road and reversed, as appropriately sign-posted.
4. The Order will come into operation on 18 July 2023, and it is anticipated that the work will be carried out overnight from 10pm to 5am. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required.
5. The restriction shall not apply in respect of:
  - (a) any vehicle involved in carrying out the said work.
  - (b) any vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes.
  - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer
