PN129 - CROYDON COUNCIL ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984, SECTION 14 AS AMENDED THE ROAD TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT 1991 AND ALL OTHER ENABLING POWERS

CUMBERLAND ROAD, SOUTH NORWOOD TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC

- 1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate telegraph pole replacement works, they have made an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily restrict traffic movements in Cumberland Road, South Norwood.
- 2. Whilst the said works are taking place, Cumberland Road will be closed between its junctions with Estcourt Road and St. Luke's Close.
- 3. Whilst the closure remains in force the alternative routes for diverted vehicular traffic will be as detailed below.
 - Via Grasmere Road, Southcote Road and Estcourt Road.
 - Via Estcourt Road, Spring Lane, Portland Road, and Grasmere Road.
- 4. The restrictions shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) any person or vehicle involved in carrying out the said works.
 - (b) any vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes.
 - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
- 5. The Order will come into operation on 01 August 2023, and it is anticipated that the works will be completed in one day. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required. The restriction will only apply during such times and to such extents as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
