The Croydon (On-Street Charged-For Parking Places) (No. 24) Order 2023

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Croydon Council on 16 October 2023 made the above Traffic Orders under section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended and all other enabling powers.

- 1. The general effect of the Orders will be to:
- a) Revoke the disabled parking places in the vicinity of No. 4 Broad Green Avenue, Croydon, No. 354 Brigstock Road, Thornton Heath, No. 37 Clarence Road, Croydon, No. 22 Helder Street, South Croydon, No. 114 Homestead Way, New Addington, No. 59 Lebanon Road, Croydon, No. 7/9 Little Roke Avenue, Kenley, No. 175 Oak Avenue, Croydon, No. 36 Selhurst Place, South Norwood, Sunderland Court, No. 2 Norbury Avenue, Thornton Heath, No. 1 Warwick Road, Thornton Heath, No. 98 Windsor Road, Thornton Heath, and No. 3 Wyvern Road, Purley.
- b) Designate new parking places at which vehicles displaying a disabled persons' badge may be left without charge or time limit in the following locations.

Outside No. 71 and partially across the frontage of No. 69
Outside No. 15 (partial footway bay - two wheels up)
Partially across the frontages of No. 118 and 120
Outside No. 53 and partially across the frontage of No. 51
Outside Nos. 115 / 117
Outside Thornton Heath Health Centre (formalising an
existing advisory bay)
Outside No. 5
Outside No. 70
Outside No. 61 and partially across the frontage of No. 59
Outside No. 32
Outside No. 58
Partially outside Nos. 46 and 48
Outside No. 79 and partially across the frontage of No. 81
Outside No. 21 (replaces a section of yellow line)
Outside No. 8
Outside No. 77
Outside No. 39 (partial footway bay - two wheels up)
Adjacent to the flank wall of No. 46 High Street, Thornton
Heath (formalising an existing advisory bay)
Adjacent to the flank wall of No. 33 Mayday Road (replaces
a section of yellow line)

- c) Amend the map-based tiles to the Schedule attached to the above Orders to accurately represent the new parking arrangements as they exist on site.
- 2. Copies of the Orders, which will come into operation on 23 October 2023 and of all associated Orders can be inspected between 9am and 4pm, Monday to Friday inclusive, until the last day of a period of six weeks beginning with the date on which the Orders are made by appointment with the Parking Design Team, at Bernard Wetherill House, 8 Mint Walk, Croydon, CR0 1EA (telephone 020 8726 6000 and ask for Parking Design). - 3. Any person desiring to question the validity of the Orders or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any relevant regulations made there under have not been complied with in relation to the Orders may, within six weeks of the date on which the Orders were made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
