NEW ADDINGTON CHRISTMAS LIGHTS ASSOCIATED RESTRICTIONS

- 1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate the switching on of the New Addington Christmas lights they intend to make a Traffic Order the effect of which will be to:
 - (a) temporarily prohibit vehicles from proceeding in Central Parade, New Addington.
 - (b) introduce waiting and loading restrictions operating "at any time" in the following locations:
 - (i) Overbury Crescent
 - (a) from its junction with Parkway south-westward for 100.00 metres.
 - (b) from its junction with the carriageway comprised in the roundabout at the junctions of Salcot Crescent, Arnhem Drive, Overbury Crescent and Central Parade south-westward for a distance of 100.00 metres.
 - (ii) The carriageway comprised in the roundabout at the junctions of Salcot Crescent, Arnhem Drive, Overbury Crescent and Central Parade

the south-east side, between its junctions with Arnhem Drive and Overbury Crescent

- The provisions of the Order will not prevent access being maintained for pedestrians to any premises situated on or adjacent to any road to which this Order relates, or to any other premises accessible from, and only from, such a road.
- Whilst the closure remains in force, the alternative route for diverted traffic will be via Salcot Crescent and Overbury Crescent, as appropriately signed.
- 4. The Order will come into effect on 25 November 2023 and will remain in force for approximately three hours from 5pm.
