TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC ORDER COURT AVENUE, OLD COULSDON SWITCHING ON OF CHRISTMAS LIGHTS

ASSOCIATED RESTRICTIONS

- 1. Croydon Council, HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate the switching on of the Christmas lights, they intend to make a Traffic Order, the effect of which will be to temporarily close Court Avenue, Old Coulsdon, to vehicular traffic between its junction with Coulsdon Road and No. 10 Court Avenue.
- 2. The provisions of the Order will not prevent access being maintained for pedestrians to any premises situated on or adjacent to any road to which this Order relates, or to any other premises accessible from, and only from, such a road.
- 3. Nothing in the Order shall apply:
 - a) to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or Civil Enforcement Officer.
 - b) to any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes, or the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity, or water to premises in the area, which necessitates the bringing of vehicles into a section of road to which the order applies.
- 4. During the event traffic will be diverted via Coulsdon Road and Keston Avenue, as appropriately signed.
- 5. The Order will come into effect on 25 November 2023 and will remain in force from 12 noon to 7.00pm.
