TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC

- 1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate works to replace a defective telegraph pole, they intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily restrict traffic movements in Chesney Crescent, New Addington.
- 2. Whilst the said works are taking place Chesney Crescent will be closed at its junction with Headley Drive.
- 3. Whilst the closure remains in force the alternative route for diverted traffic will be via Headley Drive, Dunley Drive, Chesney Crescent and vice versa, as appropriately signed.
- 4. The Order will come into operation on 02 February 2024, and it is anticipated that the work will be carried out within one day. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required.
- 5. The restriction shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) any vehicle involved in carrying out the said works.
 - (b) any vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes.
 - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
