## HIGH STREET & STATION ROAD, SOUTH NORWOOD TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC

- Croydon Council, HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate telecommunications network installation works, they intend to make an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic movements in High Street and Station Road, South Norwood.
- 2. Whilst the said works are taking place:
- a) High Street, South Norwood will be closed south-west bound (towards Station Road) between its junctions with Portland Road and Station Road.
- b) Station Road will be closed south-east bound (towards Norwood Junction Station) between its junction with High Street, South Norwood, and Nos. 1 to 7 Station Road.
- 3. Whilst the Order remains in force the alternative routes for vehicular traffic will be as detailed below and appropriately signed.
  - Via South Norwood Hill, Whitehorse Lane, Windmill Road, St. James's Road, Sumner Road, Mitcham Road, Roman Way, Old Town, The Croydon Flyover, Barclay Road, Fairfield Road, Chepstow Road, Addiscombe Road, Shirley Road, Lower Addiscombe Road, Spring Lane and Portland Road.
  - Via Oliver Grove, High Street, Belgrave Road, Grosvenor Road, and High Street.
- 4. The Order will come into operation on 05 February 2024, and it is anticipated that the work will be completed over two nights between 9pm and 5am. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required.
- 5. These restrictions shall not apply in respect of:
  - (a) any vehicle involved in carrying out the said work.
  - (b) any vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes.
  - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
