ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984, SECTION 14 AS AMENDED THE ROAD TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT 1991 AND ALL OTHER ENABLING POWERS

CHURCH STREET & FRITH ROAD, CROYDON

TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC & PARKING

- 1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate track repair works on behalf of Tramlink, they intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily restrict vehicular traffic movements and parking in Church Street and Frith Road, Croydon.
- 2. Whilst the said works are taking place:
 - a) Church Street will be closed between its junctions with Middle Street and Old Palace Road.
 - b) Parking and loading bays will be suspended in the following locations.
 - (i) Church Street (between its junctions with Middle Street and Old Palace Road).
 - (ii) Frith Road (the entire length).
- 3. Whilst the closures remain in force, the alternative route for diverted traffic will be via Drummond Road, Reeves Corner, Roman Way (A236), Lower Coombe Street, High Street, Whitgift Street, Charles Street and Church Road, as appropriately signed.
- 4. The Order will come into operation on 10 February 2024, and it is anticipated that the work will be completed on 24 February 2024. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required.
- 5. The restriction shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) any vehicle involved in carrying out the said works.
 - (b) any vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes.
 - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
