BIDDULPH ROAD, SOUTH CROYDON

TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF PARKING

- 1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate the movement of construction vehicles at a development site, they intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily restrict parking in Biddulph Road, South Croydon.
- 2. Whilst the said building development works are taking place, waiting will be prohibited on the southern (even-numbered) side of Biddulph Road, from a point opposite the south-eastern boundary of No. 27 to a point opposite the common boundary of Nos. 29 and 30b Biddulph Road. The restriction will operate from 8am to 6pm, Monday to Saturday.
- 3. The Order will come into operation on 22 March 2024, and will remain in force for a maximum of 18 months.
- 4. The restriction shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) any construction vehicle involved in carrying out the said works.
 - (b) any vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes.
 - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
