# PROPOSED INTRODUCTION OF NEW OR AMENDMENT OF EXISTING PARKING BAYS WAITING RESTRICTIONS & SCHOOL KEEP CLEAR VARIOUS LOCATIONS WITHIN THE LONDON BOROUGH OF CROYDON

The Croydon (Prohibition and Restriction of Stopping, Loading and Waiting) and (Free Parking Places) (No.5) Order 2024

The Croydon (On-Street Charged-For Parking Places) (No.5) Order 2024

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Croydon Council on 11 March 2024 made the above Traffic Orders under the relevant sections of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended and all other enabling powers.
- 2. The general effect of the Orders would be:
  - (a) To introduce new or amend existing parking places, waiting restrictions and School Keep Clear restrictions in the locations detailed in the Schedule to this Notice.
  - (b) To adjust existing restrictions to accommodate the new or amended arrangements where necessary.
  - (c) To amend the map-based tiles to the Schedule attached to the above Orders to accurately represent the new parking arrangements as they exist on site.
- 3. Copies of the Orders, which will come into operation on 18 March 2024 and of all associated Orders can be inspected between 9am and 4pm on Mondays to Fridays inclusive until the end of six weeks from the date on which the Orders were made, by appointment with the Parking Design Team, at Bernard Wetherill House, 8 Mint Walk, Croydon, CR0 1EA (telephone 020 8726 6000 and ask for Parking Design).

- 5. Any person desiring to question the validity of the Orders or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any relevant regulations made there under have not been complied with in relation to the Orders may, within six weeks of the date on which the Orders were made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
