CHURCHILL ROAD, SOUTH CROYDON

TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF TRAFFIC

- 1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate works on behalf of Openreach, they have made an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily restrict traffic movements in Churchill Road, South Croydon.
- 2. Whilst the said works are taking place Churchill Road will be closed at its southwestern junction with Brighton Road (adjacent to No. 390 Brighton Road).
- 3. Whilst the closures remain in force the alternative route for diverted traffic will be via Brighton Road and the north-eastern junction of Churchill Road with Brighton Road, as appropriately signposted.
- 4. The Order will come into operation on 18 March 2024, and it is anticipated that the works will be carried out in two days. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required.
- 5. The restriction shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) any vehicle involved in carrying out the said works.
 - (b) any vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes.
 - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
