## PN388 CROYDON COUNCIL ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984, SECTION 14 AS AMENDED THE ROAD TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT 1991 AND ALL OTHER ENABLING POWERS NURSERY ROAD, THORNTON HEATH TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC

- 1. Croydon Council, HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate water main connection works on behalf of Thames Water they have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic movements in Nursery Road, Thornton Heath.
- 2. Whilst the said works are taking place:
- a) Nursery Road will be closed to vehicular traffic at its junction with the High Street, Thornton Heath.
- b) The north-western footway of Nursery Road will be closed between its junction with the High Street, Thornton Heath, and a point opposite the south-western wall of No. 123 High Street.
- 3. During the closure the alternative routes for vehicular traffic will be via High Street, Gillett Road, Elm Road and vice versa, or via High Street, Whitehorse Road, Zion Place and vice versa, as appropriately signposted. Pedestrians will be directed to the opposite footway.
- 4. The Order will come into operation on 21 March 2024, and it is anticipated that the work will be carried out within approximately 12 days. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required.
- 5. These restrictions shall not apply in respect of:
  - (a) any vehicle involved in carrying out the said work.
  - (b) any vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes.
  - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
