LANSDOWNNE ROAD, CROYDON

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC

1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate SGN disconnection works, they have made an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily prohibit vehicular traffic movements in Lansdownne Road, Croydon.
2. Whilst the said works are taking place:
 - a) Vehicles will be banned from turning left from Walpole Road into Lansdownne Road.
 - b) The cycle lane in Lansdownne Road will be closed between its junction with Walpole Road and Dingwall Road (south).
3. Whilst the closure remains in force the alternative route for diverted traffic will be via Lansdownne Road, Dingwall Road, and George Street as appropriately signposted. Cyclists affected by the cycle lane closure will be diverted onto the pavement, which will become a temporary shared footway.
4. The Order will come into operation on 28 March 2024, and it is anticipated that the work will be carried out within seven days. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required. The prohibitions will only apply during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
5. These restrictions shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) any vehicle involved in carrying out the said works.
 - (b) any vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes.
 - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
