ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984, SECTION 14, AS AMENDED SOUTH NORWOOD HILL, SOUTH NORWOOD TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC

- 1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate works by Thames Water in South Norwood Hill at the junction of High Street, South Norwood, they have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily restrict heavy goods traffic turning into South Norwood Hill.
- Whilst the said works are taking place Heavy Good Vehicles (HGVs) will be banned from turning from the High Street, South Norwood, into South Norwood Hill.
- 3. Whilst the restrictions are in force the diversion routes for HGVs will be via the routes below.
 - South-westbound Via Manor Road, Portland Road, Lower Addiscombe Road, Shirley Road, Addiscombe Road, Chepstow Road, Fairfield Road, Barclay Road, The Croydon Flyover, Pump Pail South, Old Town, Roman Way, Mitcham Road, Sumner Road, St James Road, Windmill Road, Whitehorse Road, and Whitehorse Lane.
 - North-eastbound Via High Street South Norwood, Penge Road, Croydon Road, Anerley Road, Anerley Hill, and Church Road.
- 4. The Order will come into operation on 19 April 2024, and it is anticipated that the work will be carried out within two days. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required.
- 5. The restrictions shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) Any HGV involved in carrying out the said works.
 - (b) Any vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes.
 - (c) Anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
