WOODPLACE LANE, COULSDON

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC

- 1. Croydon Council, HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate Openreach network upgrade works, they intend to make an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily restrict vehicular movements in Woodplace Lane, Coulsdon.
- 2. Whilst the said works are taking place Woodplace Lane will be closed between its junction with Pretty Lane and the common boundary of Nos. 63 and 65 Woodplace Lane.
- 3. Whilst the Order remains in force the alternative route for traffic will be via Downs Road, Fairdene Road, Reddown Road, Marlpit Lane, Brighton Road, Netherne Drive, Rookery Mead, Bowen Way, Broadwood Road, Park Lane and vice versa.
- 4. The Order will come into operation on 10 June 2024, and it is anticipated that the work will be carried out in five days. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required.
- 5. The restriction shall not apply in respect of:
- (a) A vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes.
- (b) Any vehicle involved in the said works.
- (c) Anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
