ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984, SECTION 14  
AS AMENDED AND THE ROAD TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT  
1991  
JARVIS ROAD, SOUTH CROYDON  
TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF PARKING & PEDESTRIAN TRAFFIC

1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate water service pipe works by Thames Water, they intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily restrict pedestrian traffic and parking in Jarvis Road
2. Whilst the said work is taking place:
  - a) parking will be suspended and temporary waiting and loading restrictions will apply “at any time” on both sides of Jarvis Road outside Nos. 10 to 18.
  - b) the footway outside Nos. 10 to 18 Jarvis Road will be closed.
3. During the footway closure, pedestrians will be diverted to the opposite side of the road.
4. The Order will come into operation on 17 February 2025, and it is anticipated that the work will be completed in four days. However, the Order will remain in force for a maximum duration of 18 months to be reintroduced if further work is required.
5. These restrictions shall not apply in respect of:
  - (a) a vehicle or person involved in carrying out the said work.
  - (b) a vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes, or the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity or water to premises in the area, which necessitates the bringing of vehicles into a section of road to which the order applies.
  - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
