UNION ROAD, CROYDON

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC & PARKING

- Croydon Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate works to a
 water service pipe on behalf of Thames Water, they intend to make an
 Order the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic
 movements and parking in Union Road.
- 2. Whilst the said works are taking place:
- a) Union Road will be closed between its northernmost junction with Whitehorse Road (located between Nos. 73 and 75 Whitehorse Road) and the common boundary of Nos. 65 and 67 Union Road.
- b) The permit/payment parking bay on the north side of Union Road, adjacent to the flank wall of Nos. 75 to 77 Whitehorse Road, will be suspended and waiting and loading restrictions will apply at any time.
- 3. During the closure, the alternative routes for vehicular traffic will be as detailed below and appropriately signed.
 - Via A212 and A213, Windmill Road.
 - Via A212, A222, and A213, Windmill Road.
 - Via Union Road, A213, Windmill Road, and A212.
- 4. The Order will come into operation on 22 February 2025, and it is anticipated that the works will be completed within two days. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required.
- 5. These restrictions shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) any vehicle involved in conducting the said works.
 - (b) any vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes.
 - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
