ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984, SECTION 14 AS AMENDED THE ROAD TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT 1991

AND ALL OTHER ENABLING POWERS HOWDEN ROAD, SOUTH NORWOOD TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC & PARKING

- 1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate water valve installation works on behalf of Thames Water, they have made an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily prohibit vehicular traffic movements and parking in Howden Road.
- 2. Whilst the said works are taking place:
- a) Howden Road will be closed at its junction with South Norwood Hill.
- b) One-way working in Howden Road will be suspended to allow two-way traffic.
- c) The disabled bay on the north-west side of Howden Road near the junction with South Norwood Hill will be suspended.
- 3. Whilst the closure is in place the alternative route for traffic will be via Howden Road, Auckland Road, Woodvale Avenue and vice versa, as appropriately signed.
- 4. The Order will come into operation on 17 February 2025, and it is anticipated that the work will be completed within four days. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required. The prohibitions will only apply during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- 5. These restrictions shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) any vehicle involved in carrying out the said works.
 - (b) any vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes.
 - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
