ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984, SECTION 14
AND THE ROAD TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT 1991
WELLESLEY ROAD, CROYDON
TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC

1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate tramway renewal works on behalf of London Trams, they have made an Order, the effect of which will be to temporarily restrict traffic in Wellesley Road, Croydon.
2. During the said works:
 - a) The south-eastbound bus lane on the north-east side of Wellesley Road will be closed between The Quarters, Croydon, No. 20 Wellesley Road, and its junction with Park Lane.
 - b) The pedestrian crossing outside 19 Wellesley Road will be closed and pedestrians will be diverted to an alternative crossing in George Street.
3. Whilst the restrictions are in force Traffic Marshalls will manage access for buses.
4. The restrictions shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) any vehicle involved in carrying out the said work.
 - (b) any vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes.
 - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
5. The Order will come into operation on 14 February 2025, and it is anticipated that the works will be completed on 24 February 2025. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be re-introduced should further work be required.
