## PARK LANE, CROYDON

## TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC

- 1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate the installation of a hydrant and washout on behalf of Thames Water, they have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit vehicular traffic movements in Park Lane, Croydon.
- 2. Whilst the said works are taking place Park Lane will be closed south westbound (towards St George's Walk) at its junction with Park Street.
- 3. During the closure, the alternative route for traffic will be via St George's Walk and Katharine Street, as appropriately signed.
- 4. The Order will come into operation on 17 March 2025, and it is anticipated that the work will be carried out within four days. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required.
- 5. These restrictions shall not apply in respect of:
  - (a) any vehicle involved in carrying out the said work.
  - (b) any vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes.
  - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
