CALLEY DOWN CRESCENT, NEW ADDINGTON
TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC

1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate gas main replacement work by SGN, they intend to make an Order, the effect of which would be to temporarily restrict traffic in Calley Down Crescent, New Addington.
2. Whilst the said works are taking place, Calley Down Crescent will be closed at the locations detailed below.
 - a) At its junction with Arnhem Drive.
 - b) Outside Nos. 37 to 39 Calley Down Crescent.
 - c) The east to west arm of Calley Down Crescent (located between Nos. 37 and 39) between its junction with the north to south arm of Calley Down Crescent and its junction with Windham Avenue.
3. Whilst the closures are in operation the alternative routes for traffic will be as detailed below and appropriately signed.
 - Closure at Arnhem Drive junction – Via Arnhem Drive, King Henrys Drive, Calley Down Crescent.
 - Closure at east to west arm of Calley Down Crescent – Via King Henrys Drive, Windham Avenue or King Henrys Drive, Arnhem Drive.
4. The Order will come into operation on 07 April 2025, and it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 30 May 2025. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required.
5. These restrictions shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) any vehicle involved in carrying out the said work.
 - (b) a vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes, or the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity or water to premises in the area, which necessitates the bringing of vehicles into a section of road to which the order applies.
 - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
