CROYDON COUNCIL ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984, SECTION 14 AS AMENDED THE ROAD TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT 1991 AND ALL OTHER ENABLING POWERS

COULSDON ROAD, COULSDON TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC

- 1. Croydon Council, HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate works by SGN to install new gas mains, they have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit vehicular traffic movements in Coulsdon Road.
- 2. Whilst the said works are taking place Coulsdon Road will be closed at its junction with Hartley Down.
- 3. During the closure, the alternative route for traffic will be via Stoats Nest Road, Brighton Road, Farthing Way, Marlpit Lane and Coulsdon Road, as appropriately signed.
- 4. The Order will come into operation on 05 April 2025, and it is anticipated that the works will be completed on 21 April 2025. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required.
- 5. The restriction shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) any vehicle involved in carrying out the said work.
 - (b) a vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes, or the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity or water to premises in the area, which necessitates the bringing of vehicles into a section of road to which the order applies.
 - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
