VINCENT ROAD, CROYDON

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC & PARKING

- Croydon Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate works on behalf of Thames Water, they have made an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily prohibit vehicular traffic movements and parking in Vincent Road, Croydon.
- 2. During the works:
- a) Vincent Road will be closed between the common boundaries of Nos. 8 and 10 and Nos. 9 and 11 Vincent Road.
- b) Parking will be suspended and waiting and loading restrictions will apply outside Nos. 8a and 11 Vincent Road.
- 3. Whilst the closure remains in force the alternative route for diverted traffic will be via Vincent Road, Leicester Road, Stretton Road and vice versa.
- 4. The Order will come into operation on 23 April 2025, and it is anticipated that the work will be carried out within one day. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further works be required. The prohibitions will only apply during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- 5. The restriction shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) any vehicle involved in carrying out the said works.
 - (b) a vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes, or the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity or water to premises in the area, which necessitates the bringing of vehicles into a section of road to which the order applies.
 - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
