ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984, SECTION 14, AS AMENDED BRIGSTOCK ROAD & COTFORD ROAD, THORNTON HEATH TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC & PARKING

- 1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate utility repair and maintenance works and a district meter exchange on behalf of Thames Water, they have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily restrict traffic and parking in Brigstock Road and Cotford Road, Thornton Heath.
- 2. Whilst the said works are taking place:
- a) Heavy Good Vehicles (HGVs) will be banned from turning from London Road into Brigstock Road (buses that can pass through the works area are permitted to make the turn).
- b) Parking in the parking bays in Cotford Road, adjacent to the flank walls of No. 6 Brigstock Road and Ambassador House, No.1 Brigstock Road, will be suspended.
- 3. Whilst the restrictions are in force the diversion route for HGVs will be via London Road, Windmill Road, Whitehorse Road, High Street, and Brigstock Road.
- 4. The Order will come into operation on 24 May 2025, and it is anticipated that the work will be completed on 01 June 2025. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required.
- 5. The restrictions shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) any HGV involved in carrying out the said work.
 - (b) a vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes, or the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity or water to premises in the area, which necessitates the bringing of vehicles into a section of road to which the order applies.
 - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
