### b) The prevention of Crime and disorder

The premises shall maintain a comprehensive CCTV system. All entry and exit points will be covered enabling frontal identification of every person entering in any light condition. The CCTV system shall continually record whilst the premises is open to the public and the recordings shall be stored for a minimum period of 31 days with date and time stamping. Recordings shall be made available to an authorised officer or police officer together with facilities for viewing. A staff member from the premises who is conversant with the operation of the CCTV system shall be on the premises at all times when the premises is open and be able to provide a Police or authorised council officer copies of recent CCTV images or data with the absolute minimum of delay when requested. A record shall be kept detailing all refused sales of alcohol. The record should include the date and time of the refused sale and the name of the member of staff who refused the sale. The record shall be available for inspection at the premises by the police or an authorised officer of the City Council at all times whilst the premises is open.

### e) The protection of children from harm

A Challenge 25 proof of age scheme shall be operated at the premises where the only acceptable forms of identification are recognised photographic identification cards, such as a driving licence, passport or proof of age card with the PASS Hologram. Challenge 25 signage shall be displayed within the premises.

Each member of staff authorised to sell alcohol will receive adequate training on the law with regard to alcohol sales. All training will be properly documented and retained. The training records will be kept on the premises and made available for inspection by authorised officers
