ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 16A AS AMENDED BY
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION (SPECIAL EVENTS) ACT 1994
TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC & PARKING ORDER
CROYDON CARNIVAL – LONDON ROAD AREA
ASSOCIATED RESTRICTIONS

1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate the Croydon Carnival event they intend to make a Traffic Order the effect of which will be to restrict traffic and parking in London Road and roads in the surrounding area.
2. Whilst the carnival is taking place, the effect of the Order will be to:
 - a) Close London Road to through traffic between its junction with Sumner Road and the north-western kerb-line of the vehicular entrance to Lidl, No. 99 London Road.
 - b) Close the following side roads at their junctions with London Road
 - i. Chatfield Road
 - ii. Hathaway Road
 - iii. Kidderminster Road
 - iv. Montague Road
 - v. Nova Road
 - c) Suspend parking and introduce waiting and loading restrictions operating “at any time” in the following roads.
 - i. Derby Road, both sides between its junctions with Parsons Mead and London Road.
 - ii. Handcroft Road, the south-west side, between its junctions with Sumner Road and Montague Road.
 - iii. London Road, both sides between its junction with Sumner Road and the north-western kerb-line of the vehicular entrance to Lidl, No. 99 London Road.
 - iv. Parsons Mead, the south-west side between Chatfield Road and Nelson’s Close.
3. The provisions of the Order will not prevent access being maintained for pedestrians to any premises.
4. The Order will come into effect on 10 August 2025 and will remain in force for one day from approximately 7.00am to 9.00pm.
5. Whilst the prohibitions remain in force, the alternative routes for diverted traffic will be as detailed below and appropriately signed.
 - Via Sumner Road, Mitcham Road, Roman Way, Old Town, Pump Pail North, Park Lane, Wellesley Road, and Station Road.
 - Via St James’s Road, Hogarth Crescent, Newgate, Wellesley Road and Station Road.
 - Via Tamworth Road, Drummond Road, Reeves Corner, Old Town Round-about, Old Town, Mitcham Road, and Sumner Road.
