Schedule

Proposed Toucan Crossing

The crossing points will be in two 4-metre-wide sections positioned on Ampere Way immediately adjacent to the junction with Volta Way, either side of the central reservation/road island opposite Ikea as follows:

- On the north-east side of Ampere Way, the zig-zag markings would extend 16.79 metres to the north-west and 17.04 metres to the southeast of the crossing point.
- On the south-west side of Ampere Way, the zig-zag markings would extend 4.5 metres to the north-west and 16.88 metres to the southeast of the crossing point.

Amendment to Existing Pelican Crossing

The zig-zag markings to the south-east of the existing pelican crossing outside the Ampere Way Tram stop would be reduced from 17 metres to 8.7 metres to accommodate changes required to install the new crossing detailed above.
