PROPOSED RAISED ENTRY TREATMENT

VOLTA WAY, CROYDON

Croydon Council HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that they propose to install a raised entry treatment as specified in the Schedule to this Notice to help reduce vehicular speeds, improve road safety and provide a crossing point for pedestrians at this location.

**Schedule**

It is intended to place a raised entry treatment in the carriageway in accordance with the Highways (Road Humps) Regulations 1999. As a guide the tabletop will be 5 metres long and span the width of Volta Way (the Ikea entrance/exit). It will be between 80mm and 100mm high with an approximate ramp gradient of 1:20 at the Ampere Way junction and 1:30 on the Ikea side. It will be situated in the following location.
