

**DISABLED PERSONS PARKING PLACES – SCHEDULE 248**

The Croydon (Prohibition and Restriction of Stopping, Loading and Waiting) and  
(Free Parking Places) (No.19) Order 2025

The Croydon (On-Street Charged-For Parking Places) (No.19) Order 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Croydon Council on 15 September 2025 made the above Traffic Orders under section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended and all other enabling powers.

**1. The general effect of the Orders will be to:**

- a) **Revoke the disabled parking places in the vicinity of No. 54 Aldrich Crescent, Croydon, No. 7 Colescroft Hill, Purley, No. 258 Davidson Road, Croydon, No. 24 Kitchener Road, Thornton Heath, No. 72 Langdale Road, Thornton Heath, No. 62 Lansdowne Road, Purley, and No. 31 Woodside Avenue, South Norwood.**
- b) **Designate new parking places at which vehicles displaying a disabled persons' badge may be left without charge or time limit in the following locations.**

<b>Avondale Road, South Croydon</b>	<b>Outside No. 56</b>
<b>Cumberlow Avenue, South Norwood</b>	<b>Adjacent to the flank wall of Stanley Arts, No. 12 South Norwood Hill, next to an existing disabled bay (replaces a length of single yellow line).</b>
<b>Davidson Road, Croydon</b>	<b>Outside No. 580</b>
<b>Harewood Gardens, South Croydon</b>	<b>Outside No. 69</b>
<b>Hastings Road, Croydon</b>	<b>Outside Nos. 45 and 47 (replaces one space in a permit/payment bay)</b>
<b>Hathaway Road, Croydon</b>	<b>Adjacent to the flank wall of No. 248 London Road (replaces one space in a permit/payment bay)</b>
<b>Homestead Way, New Addington</b>	<b>Adjacent to the flank wall of Nos. 159-181</b>
<b>Lodge Road, Croydon</b>	<b>Outside No. 6 and partially across the frontage of No.8 (replaces one space in a permit/payment bay)</b>
<b>Lower Addiscombe Road, Croydon</b>	<b>Outside No. 438</b>
<b>Mansfield Road, South Croydon</b>	<b>Outside No. 23 and partially across the frontage of No. 21</b>
<b>Newlands Road, Norbury</b>	<b>Outside No. 27</b>
<b>Norbury Crescent, Norbury</b>	<b>Outside No. 41</b>
<b>Norman Road, Thornton Heath</b>	<b>Outside No. 35</b>
<b>Oakhill Road, Norbury</b>	<b>Outside No. 6</b>
<b>Oaklands Avenue, Thornton Heath</b>	<b>Outside No. 30</b>
<b>The Ridgeway, Croydon</b>	<b>Outside No. 84</b>
<b>Thirsk Road, South Norwood</b>	<b>Outside No. 29 and partially across the frontage of No. 27 (replaces one space in a permit/payment bay)</b>
<b>Tirrell Road, Croydon</b>	<b>Adjacent to the flank wall of No. 32 Beulah Grove (replaces one space in a permit/payment bay)</b>
<b>Trafford Road, Thornton Heath</b>	<b>Outside No. 13</b>

- c) **Amend the map-based tiles to the Schedule attached to the above Orders to accurately represent the new parking arrangements as they exist on site.**
2. Copies of the Orders, which will come into operation on 22 September 2025 and of all associated Orders can be inspected between 9am and 4pm, Monday to Friday inclusive, until the last day of a period of six weeks beginning with the date on which the Orders are made or, as the case may be, the Council decides not to make the Orders, by appointment with the Parking Design Team, 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor, Zone C, Bernard Wetherill House, 8 Mint Walk, Croydon, CR0 1EA (telephone 020 8726 6000 and ask for Parking Design). 3. Any person desiring to question the validity of the Orders or of any provision contained therein on the ground that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any relevant regulations made there under have not been complied with in relation to the Orders may, within six weeks of the date on which the Orders were made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
